SULA WINE

- **Sula Vineyards** (or "**Sula**") is a winery and vineyard located in the Nashik region of western India,180 km northeast of Mumbai.
- After the launch of its first wines in 2000, Sula expanded from its original 30 acre family estate in Nashik to approximately 1800 acres across Nashik and the state of Karnataka
- The annual live music festival 'Sula Fest' takes place at their Nasik winery.
- Sula Fest is an annual two-day 'gourmet world music festival' held at Sula Vineyards in Nasik.
- With an exception to the 10th Sula Fest which was a three-day festival.
- Started in 2008, this festival offers music, drinks, food, and fashion.
- Some of the activities the festival-goers can engage in include grape stomping, wine tasting, and camping.







VALLONNE VINEYARDS



YORK WINERY

- Built in 2006, York Winery occupies seven acres of vineyards overlooking Gangapur Dam, close to Sula Vineyards. This friendly, young family-owned winery focuses on producing fruity and dry, rather than sweet, wines. It's definitely going places and is already winning awards. The winery has a superb gold medal Reserve Shiraz, aged in oak, to its name. Also impressive is its new Arros reserve blend of shiraz and cabernet sauvignon, released in late 2014. York released its own sparkling wine, York Sparkling Brut, near the end of 2014 as well. It's made from 100% chenin blanc grapes.
- The sizable tasting room is attractively decorated in warm, earthy tones. Calmer and less commercialized than Sula, it's a great sunset destination.
- **Open:** Noon until 10.00 p.m., seven days a week...
- Wines: Sauvignon blanc, chenin blanc, rose, shiraz, cabernet sauvignon.


