Overview of Puri

- Odisha (formerly Orissa), an eastern Indian state on the Bay of Bengal, is known for its tribal cultures and its many ancient Hindu temples.
- The historical state of Orissa is situated amidst beautiful lush green mountains of the Eastern Ghats.
- Dotted with numerous architecturally celebrated temples, sacred shrines, and historical monuments, Orissa is considered India's one of the most hidden splendid cultural landscapes.
- **Best time to visit:- October to March**



How to Reach Odisha

- **By Air :-**

Regular flights landing at the only major airport of the city namely Biju Patnaik Airport connect it to all the major cities of the country such as Calcutta, Delhi, Chennai, Mumbai, Vishakhapatnam, Hyderabad and Raipur.

- **By Rail :-**

There is a good train network also that connects Calcutta, Puri, Madras, Delhi, Bombay, Bangalore, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Tirupati and Trivandrum to Bhubaneswar by express and super express trains plying to and from on a daily basis.

- **By Road :-**

Orissa has a wide network of roads that connects well to the rest of the country by National highways and State highways. Bhubaneswar the capital city is well linked to all major cities with in Orissa and its neighbouring states.



Places to visit

Sri Jagannath Puri Temple



Located in the sacred town of Puri, the Jagannath Temple or the pride of India was built in the 11th century by King Indradyumna. This glorious temple is the abode of Lord Jagannath who is a form of Lord Vishnu. It is the most revered pilgrimage site for Hindus and is included in the pious Char Dham Yatra with Badrinath, Dwarka and Rameswaram.

Chilika Lake



The Chilika Lake, which is a paradise on Earth for bird watchers and nature lovers, is the largest internal salt water pond that can be found in Asia. The pear-shaped lake is dotted with a few small islands and has fisheries and salt pans around its shore. This is separated from the Bay of Bengal by a 60 kilometres long narrow strip of sand-flats and marshy islands.



Puri Beach

Adorned with fine white sand and crystal clear water, Puri Beach is quite renowned for its peaceful and calm surroundings. Puri Beach is a fine coastline of the Bay of Bengal with the sun gleaming on the pristine waters of the beach. Located at a mere distance of 35 km from the Sun Temple, the place is ideal for holiday makers looking for some solitude.



Sun Temple, Konark

Situated on the north eastern corner of Puri, Konark Sun Temple is a World Heritage site and one of the prime tourist attractions of Odisha. Pulled by a set of seven horses, four on the left side and three on the right, this massive temple is built in the form of a giant ornamented chariot of the Sun god. The word 'Konark' comes from the combination of two words 'Kona' and 'Arka'. 'Kona' means corner and 'Arka' means the sun so the temple means 'Sun of the Corner.'



Lingaraj temple

The Lingaraj Temple is an ancient shrine situated in the city of Bhubaneswar and is the largest temple situated in the city. Dedicated to Lord Shiva as the name suggests, the temple was built sometime in the 7th century by the King Jajati Keshari. The edifice of the temple is a great example of Orissa style of architecture and has intricately designed stone vaults covering the main sanctum of the temple.



RajaRani Temple

The Raja Rani Temple is locally known as the 'love temple' because it contains some sensuous carvings of women and couples. No images can be found inside the sanctum, and hence the temple is not associated with any particular sect of Hinduism. The figures of Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvati carved on the walls strongly indicate that the temple has certain associations with Shaivism.

Orissa State Museum



The Orissa State museum has an exclusive collection of some unique and ancient art and craft objects.

This collection includes stone sculptures, bronze coins, musical instruments, armours, pre-historic metal plates etc. The place is a must-visit for all history enthusiasts.

Brahmeshwara Temple



The Brahmeshwara Temple is yet another relic of the brilliance of Oriyan style of architecture. Built in the 11th century, this temple is surrounded by four smaller shrines.

The main shrine in this temple is that of a Shiva lingam and there are also sculptures of Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvati alongside. Famous for its beautiful carvings, it attracts a lot of pilgrims throughout the year.



Tikarpada Wildlife Sanctuary

The Tikarpada Wildlife Sanctuary spreads across 795.52 square kilometres and does not fail to enthrall its visitors with its overwhelming beauty, lush green surrounding, the ever cherished rambling of River Mahanadi besides the very famous Satkosia gorge and large variety of species of wild animals, birds and plants. The Gharial Sanctuary undertakes the process of breeding of the Gharial to increase their numbers and give them the right atmosphere and treatment.



Khandagiri & Udayagiri Jain caves

Also known as Cuttack caves, Khandagiri Caves are artificial caves located in the state of Orissa which date back to 2nd century. This place is quite a sight to see with all the beautifully carved inscriptions and figures. It is believed that the Khandagiri caves were dug during the rule of the great emperor of the Mahameghavahana Dynasty, King Kharavela. These caves are believed to be built by Jain and Buddhist monks who used these caves as a place to pray and meditate.



Dauli Giri Shanti Stupa

Dhauli Giri Shanti Stupa, also known as Peace Pagoda, is a Buddhist structure built jointly in 1972 by the Japan Buddha Sangh and the Kalinga Nippon Buddha Sangh. Situated on the opposite hill of Dhauli Giri, it was built through the Indo-Japanese collaboration. Constructed by the chief priest of Nipponzan Myohoji, who came to India in 1930 from Mt. Minobu, the original holy place of the Nichiren Sect, it is a domed structure.

Nandankanan Zoological park



Established in the year 1960, the Nandankanan Zoological Park covers a total area of 400 hectares, with a botanical garden as another integral part. It was in the year 1979 that the park was opened for public display and by the year 2009, the zoo gained association with World Association of Zoos and Aquariums. Nandankanan is popular for its white tiger population and it has over 34 white tigers. This zoo is home to approximately 1660 animals with 67 species of mammals, 81 species of birds and 18 species of reptiles.
