Overview

- Coorg (Kodagu) is well known in the world for coffee and its "brave warriors". Madikeri is the headquarters of Kodagu. Kodagu is home to the native speakers of Kodava language.
- Vibrantly coloured roses, bougainvillea's and marigolds surround the clusters of red-tiled and whitewashed houses. Those travellers who love nature and the unspoiled charm of villages should get off the beaten track and visit Coorg, a wild and rugged region located in the state of Karnataka.
- Kodagu is considered rich with wildlife. October to March is the **best time** for adventure activities especially trekking. March and April are the favoured months to experience the valley shrouded in white flowers



How to reach Coorg

- **Coorg by Air:**

Coorg does not have its own airport, the nearest airport being Mangalore & Bangalore, which is approximately 120 km & 135 km away. Mangalore airport has good connectivity with direct flights from different parts of the country. Flights are available from all the major cities for Coorg.

- **Coorg by Railways:**

Coorg does not possess a railway network but the stations closest to this hill station are Mysore, Mangalore and Hassan. There are many trains for these places from different parts of India.



Places to Visit

Abbey Falls



Abbey Falls sparkles as if a stream of white pearls is running down a green wall at a great speed. But if you happen to be standing on the hanging bridge right after the monsoons, the voluminous waterfall will leave you soaked by its spray of water. A number of small streams come together to form the sizzling cascade at Abbey Falls. The cascade gushes down a height of 70 feet to form a pool below that joins the River Cauvery. During the monsoon season, as the streams widen and the level of water increases, the rush down the cascade becomes thicker and lovelier to watch.

True to its name, the Raja's Seat was once the spot from where the erstwhile kings of Kodagu used to watch sunsets with their queens or consorts. The view of the scenic surrounding areas from the Raja's Seat is simply breath-taking. The toy train near the Raja's Seat is a delight for the children.

Dubare Elephant Camp



This camp has plenty of elephants which are trained under naturalists. A trained Naturalist is at hand to explain the various aspects of Elephant history, ecology and biology. The visitor can not only observe and learn but also participate in various activities involving Elephants.

It is a collection of twelve villages that host various Tibetan camps - one of the many parts in the country that became home to Tibetan refugees after they had to flee their land. The Namdroling Nyingmapa Monastery is the largest teaching center of the Nyingma lineage of Tibetan Buddhism in the world. The monastery is home to a sangha community of over five thousand lamas (both monks and nuns)

Visitors can enter the reserve through the new hanging bridge, which is not to be confused with the old hanging bridge which is no more functional. You will find a wide variety of things to do and see. Elephant ride is something that adults and kids both will enjoy. There is also a deer park and rabbit park that one can visit. The view of River Kaveri is also something that tourist must stop by and notice, capture in their cameras, and cherish forever.

Brahmagiri

The top of Brahmagiri Hill is well forested and has a lot of wildlife. Mammals in the Sanctuary include Lion-tailed Macaque, Elephant, Gaur, Tiger, Jungle Cat, Leopard Cat, Wild Dog, Sloth Bear, Wild Pig, Sambar, Spotted Deer, Nilgiri Langur, Slender Loris, Bonnet Macaque, Common Langur, Barking Deer, Mouse Deer, Malabar Giant Squirrel, Giant Flying Squirrel, Nilgiri Marten, Common Otter, Brown Mongoose, Civets, Porcupine, Pangolin. Python, cobra and king cobra are some of the reptiles found in the Brahmagiri wildlife sanctuary.



Madikeri Fort



Madikeri Fort is a unique fort that houses among other structures a temple, an Anglican Church, a prison and a museum. The fact that a Church stands within the walls of the fort signifies the dominance of the British people over the fort. The St. Marks Church was built by the British in 1855 by removing a temple of Virabhadra from the inner fort and making place for the construction of the church. It was built in the Gothic style with stained glasses windows. The fort is believed to have a few secret passageways and that adds to the mystery of the fort.

Coffee Plantation

A sprawling, coffee-scented paradise reverberating with a symphony of birds - everything about the region is sure to beckon the nature lover in you. Start the day with a trek through the plantations with a guide. Learn about the floral and faunal ecosystem in the region, appreciate the quietude of the woods or get lured by a solitary insect at work, all to come back refreshed and in tune with nature.



Nagarhole National Park



Nagarhole National Park, also known as Rajiv Gandhi National Park, is a wildlife reserve in the South Indian state of Karnataka. Part of the Nilgiri Biosphere Reserve, the park is backed by the Brahmagiri Mountains and filled with sandalwood and teak trees. The Kabini River winds through jungle landscapes, home to tigers, Asian elephants and a variety of birds. Nearby, the Irupu Falls cascade down tree-lined rocks.

Area of 258 sq. kms and subsequently enlarged to include the adjoining areas of Mysore district and now extends over an area of 643.39 sq. kms which was given the status of a National Park in 1983. Nagarhole National Park forms apart of the Nilgiri Biosphere Reserve and together with Bandipur National Park (875 sq. kms) and Mudumalai Wildlife Sanctuary (325 sq. kms) to its South East and Wayanad (350 sq. kms) to the South-West, is one of the last remaining and best protected habitats for endangered species like the Elephant and the Tiger.
