Places to visit in Muscat

Bayt Al Zubair

- Bayt Al-Zubayr is a museum located in the old Muscat city.
- The Bait Al-Zubair complex is an architectural icon. It consists of 5 buildings (Bait Al Bagh, Bait Al Dalaleel, Bait Al Oud, Bait Al Nahdhah and Gallery Sarah) and a garden, as well as a café and a gift shop.
- It is the largest private museum in the country that has a notable collection of over five thousand handpicked, donated and regal cultural heritage.



Places to visit in Muscat

Al Alam Palace (Drive 20 Min from Muscat)

- Al Alam Palace, also known as the 'Flag Palace,' is one among the six royal residences of Sultan Qaboos located in Muscat looking out to the Gulf of Oman.
- Visitors will only be allowed to see the Palace from outside the gates and can take photographs from there.
- The palace is located in the heart of the Old Muscat, it is surrounded by the Al Jalali and Al Mirani forts.



Places to visit in Muscat

Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque, Muscat

- The Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque is Oman's biggest mosque with an area of 416,000 m² and a capacity of over 20,000 worshippers; 8,000 can fit inside and the courtyard can easily hold up to 12,000.
- This mosque is one of the few mosques in Arabia which allows entry for non-Muslim visitors.
- The mosque is a wonder of modern architecture and is a fusion of Omani, Islamic, and Middle-Eastern architectural styles.



Places to visit in Muscat

Mutrah Souk

- The Mutrah Souq is one of the oldest markets in the Arab world.
- The souk sells traditional textiles, garments, jewellery, incense, frankincense, pipes, pottery and craftwork.
- Purchase souvenirs like Khanjars and coffee pots, Bedouin jewellery, and clothing (dishdashas, kummas (caps), massar (turban) and khanjar for the men; dishdashas, surwal (trousers), lihaff (shawl) for the women).

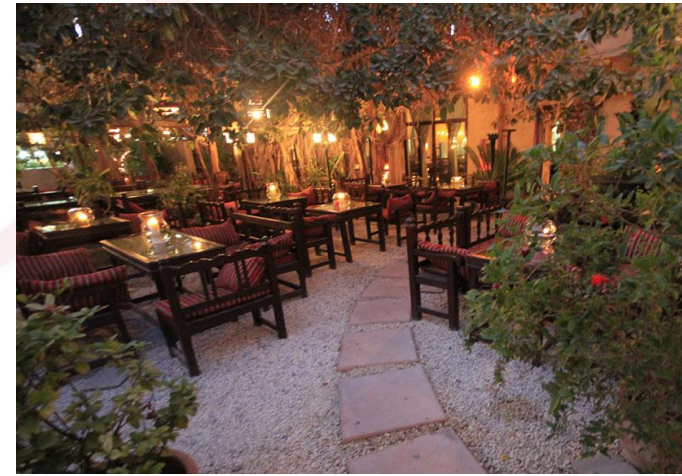
Royal Opera House

- The Royal Opera House is the first opera house in the Arabian Peninsula and is Oman's premier destination for music, arts, and culture.
- The complex consists of a theatre, auditorium, landscaped gardens, an art center, and cultural markets, and can accommodate 1100 people.
- The House serves as a centre for excellence in the arts and enriches its heritage by culturally diverse programs.



Kargeen Restaurant

- Kargeen is an old Omani word for 'little wooden cottage'.
- Kargeen is a true example of old-world charm meeting the modern-day dining experience.
- Done up in wood, wrought iron and decorated with bright rugs, the restaurant blends Eastern style with classical Western culture with ease.

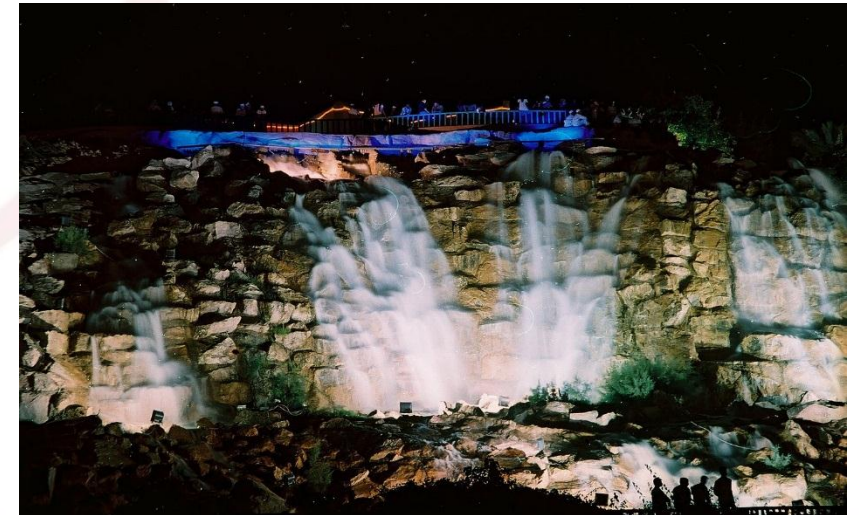

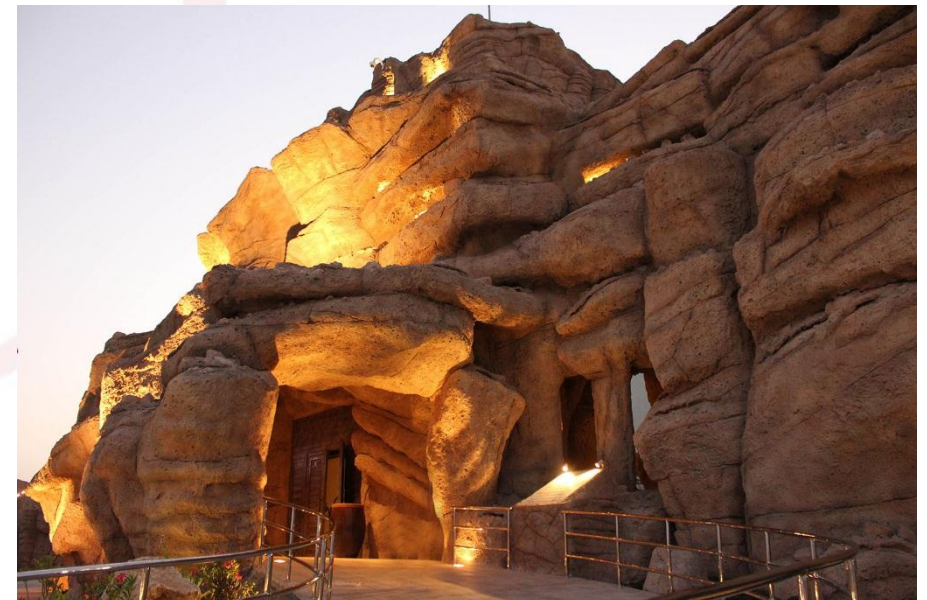
Mumtaz Mahal Restaurant

Visa - Requirement & Procedure for Tourist Visa

Oman Visa Documentation

- Scanned copies of passport valid for at least six months prior to expiry
- Scanned passport sized photographs in blue background
- Return ticket and hotel confirmation from Oman

Visa processing takes about 4-6 working days (Friday & Saturday are non-working days in Oman) subject to approval from Immigration.

Tourist Visa valid for 10 Days from the date of entry.
