Attractions

Marina by the bay-

- Marina Bay Sands complex is the focal point of the bay, and many of the great things to do and see in the area revolve around this epic building and resort, such as the Science Museum, Casino and various shopping, dining and nightlife options. Catch the spectacular light show, which illuminates the water as well as several iconic landmarks you've probably seen on postcards.



Clarke Quay-

- Clarke Quay's location takes full advantage of the picturesque body of water that emerges from the city's main river, with alfresco-style dining to be had in an endless number of eateries set around the water's edge. Head under the futuristic, jelly-like roof and you'll find some great shopping options as well as a plentiful supply of bars, making this a real bar-hoppers' heaven



Universal Studio-

- Universal Studios Singapore was the first amusement park of its kind to open in Southeast Asia. The park has more than 20 attractions in themed zones including the Lost World, Ancient Egypt, New York, Hollywood, Madagascar and Far Far Away.



Gardens by the bay-

- Gardens by the Bay is a huge, colourful, futuristic park in the bay area of Singapore; and has won countless architecture awards. The famous Supertree structures offer an impressive skywalk over the gardens, over-sized seashell-shaped greenhouses recreate chilly mountain climates and there are hundreds of trees and plants to discover, making this destination great fun for both kids and adults.



Raffles Hotel-

- This luxurious colonial-style hotel has a long history dating back to 1887 Its famous guests include Elizabeth Taylor, Queen Elizabeth II and the late King of Pop, Michael Jackson. The Raffles Hotel features 103 suites and 18 distinctive restaurants and bars as well as an arcade with over 40 boutiques



China town-

- You'll find the cheapest souvenirs here – you'll see all kind of important attractions and find plenty of authentic Chinese food. Learn about its history from the Chinatown Heritage Centre on Pagoda Street. Its main focus is on the Chinese immigrants Other attractions include Thian Hock Keng Temple, the oldest temple in Singapore, Buddha Tooth Relic Temple, Eu Yan Sang Chinese Medical Hall and Maxwell Road Food Centre.



Orchard Road-

- One of the city's most iconic streets, Orchard Road is the epicentre of shopping in Singapore and is similar to London's Oxford Street or Hong Kong's Nathan Road. Flanked on both sides by local and international department stores, tiny boutiques, offices, spas, beauty salons, hotels, entertainment spots, restaurants, and cafes, you could spend a whole day trawling the main thoroughfare.



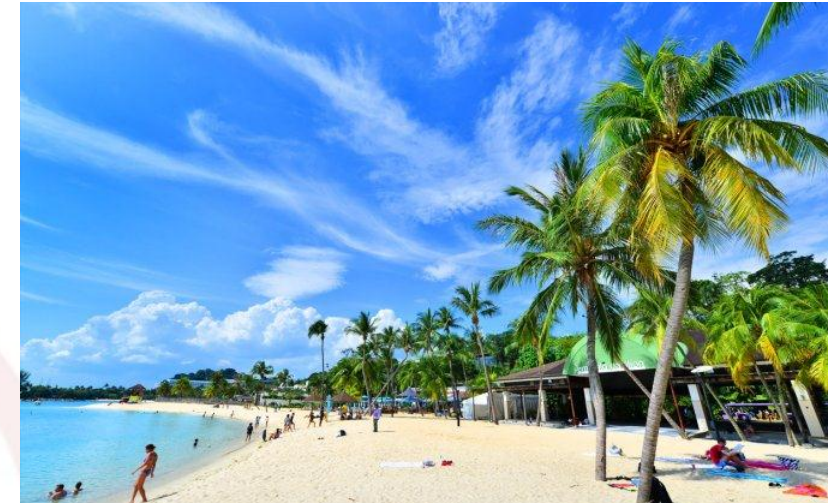
Singapore Flyer-

- Singapore Flyer is the world's largest observation wheel. the Flyer is 150 metres in diameter, 165 metres high, and travels at 0.21m per second (it is some 30 metres taller than the famous London Eye!). With breathtaking panoramic views that are so radically different during the day and at night, it's hard to choose the best time to take a ride. Passengers will get to see such city sights as the Singapore River, Raffles Place, Marina Bay, Empress Place and the Padang.



Sentosa Island-

- Sentosa is a purpose-built island off the southern tip of Singapore which was built with leisure and relaxation in mind. A collection of beaches, theme parks, golf, shopping, dining and more are all available on this strip of reclaimed land that can be reached by road or cable car. You can choose to stay in Sentosa, but even if you're not based on the island, you can easily access all the attractions via MRT in 15 minutes from downtown Singapore.



Singapore Night Safari-

- Singapore Night Safari is truly a unique attraction. It's not only an interesting place worth a visit but a leading conservation and research centre in Asia. As a zoo, it offers an unusual glimpse into the nocturnal animal kingdom, with more than 59 exhibits and 1,000 animals to be seen from around the world. These include Himalayan griffon vultures, greater one-horned rhinoceroses, wildebeests and gazelles. You can simply start with the 'Creatures of the Night' show for a good 20-minute overview of the animals to be seen here.



Merlion Park:-

- The half-fish and half-lion Merlion is a symbol of Singapore and is located directly on the Merlion Park in Marina.
- The fish body symbolizes the humility of Singapore from a small fishing village.
- The Lion Head represents Singapore's earliest name "Singapura" (Singapore La), which means "Lion City" in Malay.



Crane Dance Show:-

- What happens when two mechanical cranes meet? They fall in love and transform into real birds.
- Be wowed by this complex light, water and sound effects show, where giant cranes court and fall in love amidst a beautiful spectacle of illusion and light-play.



Jurong Bird park-

- Jurong Bird Park is one of Singapore's great family attractions, situated on Jurong Hill. It is also the largest bird park in the world, featuring 8,000 birds of more than 600 species. Founded in 1971 and managed by Wildlife Reserves Singapore, Jurong Bird Park was first initiated by Dr Goh Keng Swee, then Minister for Finance, with the prime objective of providing an exclusive leisure zone for the residents of Jurong – little more an industrial area at that time



Mustafa-

- Mustafa Centre offers a unique 24-hour market style shopping experience in Singapore. You can find designer products in abundance and at low prices here, with everything from textiles to watches and electronics on sale. The mall is 2 department stores joined together with goods sold under the Mustafa name and streamlined by type. One of the main attractions is the jewellery sections where gold can be picked up inexpensively.



Sin river cruise –

- Singapore River Cruise seeks to preserve the heritage of the Singapore River.
- Bumboats have been plying the Singapore River for more than a century. From sail powered bumboats of founding days, to silent and environmentally-friendly electric versions today, Bumboats have come a long way.
- Go round Singapore River in 40 minutes as you explore its sensational sights and sounds at a leisurely pace – as you explore its story through audio and visual commentary in English. See the world-famous Merlion, Clarke Quay, Cavenagh Bridge and more.



Sands SkyPark (Marina Bay Sands)

- Enjoy a spectacular 360-degree view of Singapore from 57 storeys above, complete with cocktails and live entertainment.
- Take in the gorgeous sunset, and marvel at the city and Gardens by the Bay illuminated at night as you party till late under the stars.

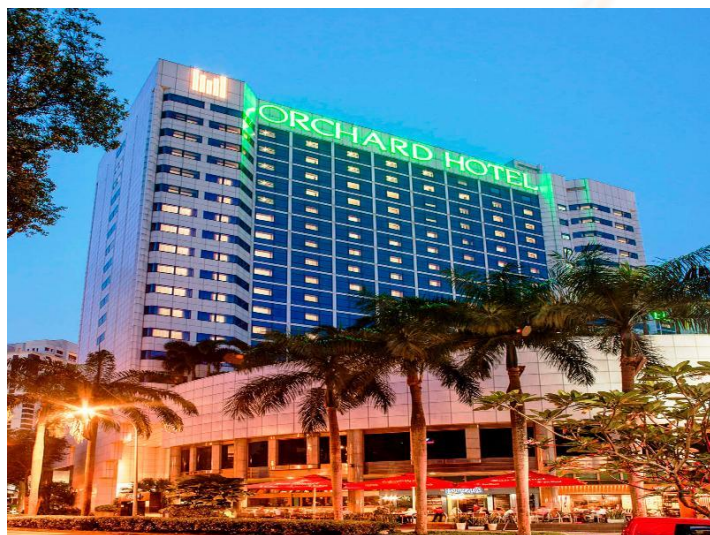

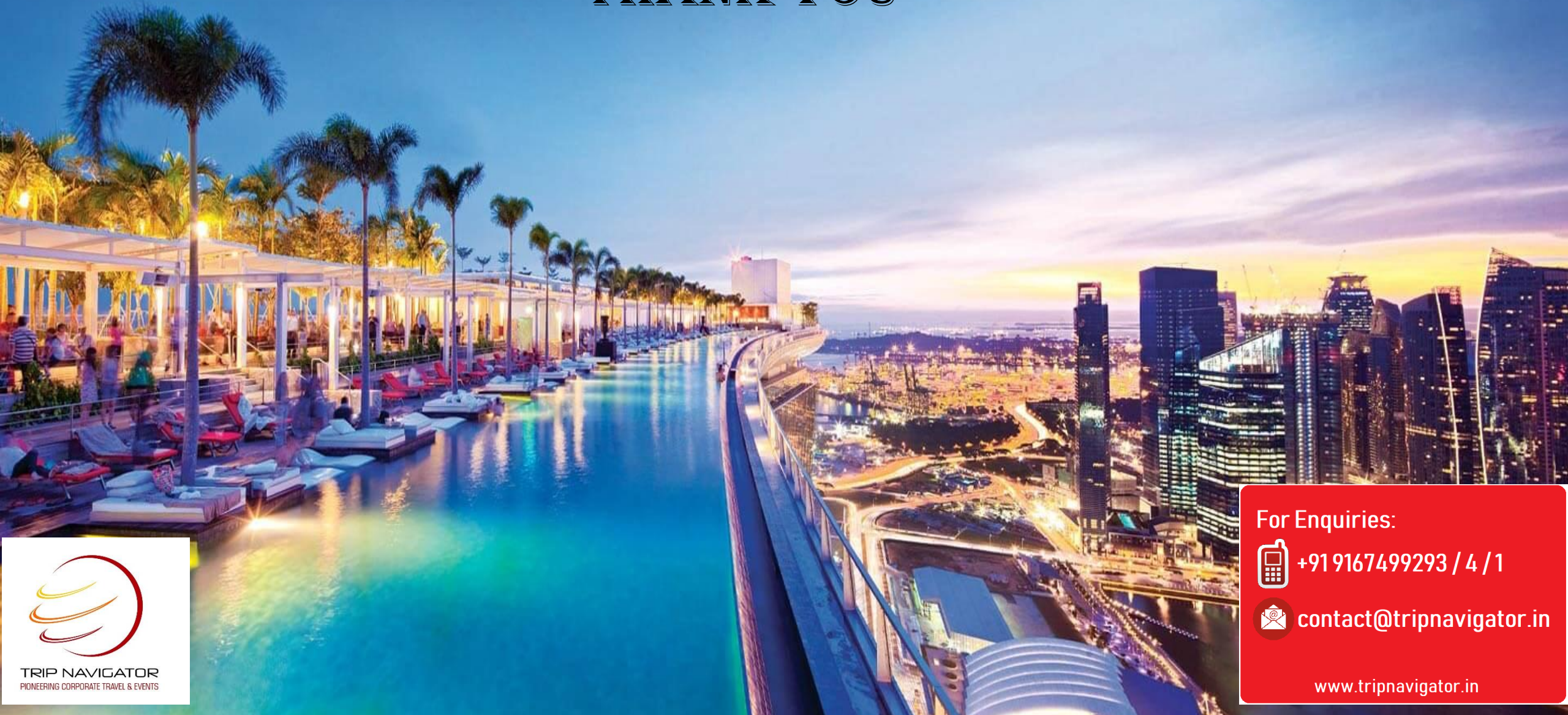
