Overview

- The north Indian town of Dharamshala is a true 'global village'.
- Dharamshala has pleasant weather conditions through the summer months, sees heavy rains during monsoon and snowfall in winters.
- The Best time to Visit Dharamshala is **March to June**.
- The Thekchen Chöling Temple Complex is a spiritual centre for Tibetan Buddhism.
- The Cricket Stadium is unique in India in that it is situated at an altitude of 1,457 m (4,780 ft. 2 in) above sea level and has the snow-capped Himalayan mountains in the background.
- Distance from Chandigarh Airport to , McLeod Ganj is 258kms which takes 5hrs 52mins approx.

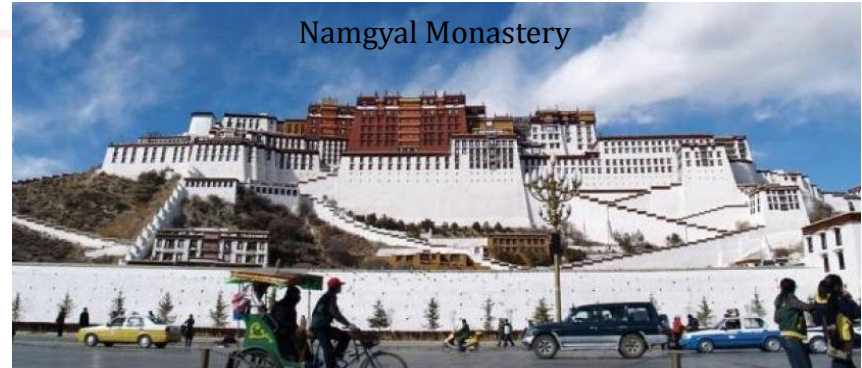

Trekking at Triund

- Triund is the crown jewel of Dharamshala, situated in the laps of dhauladhar mountains, it has the perfect view of the dhauladhar mountains on one side and kangra valley on the other.
- It is a very popular trekking spot .
- It attracts a lot of tourist every year from India and all over the world.
- The best time to visit Triund is from March to June because of the cozy and comfortable weather and clear views.
- The weather in Triund is cool and comfortable round the year, except for chilly winter months.





Bhagsu Waterfall

This enchanting waterfall is located about 11 kms from Dharamshala and is easily approachable by road. It is one of the best tourist attractions in Dharamshala and is known for its old temple, a fresh water spring, and slate quarry a waterfall surrounded by stunning cliffs and trees. Tourists can take a dip in the chilly water of this fall and visit the Bhagsunag temple to seek blessing of Lord Shiva.

HPCA Cricket Stadium

Located at the backdrop of the snow-clad mountains, is perched on the high slopes in the upper part of Kangra Valley. Sitting at 1457 meters above sea level, it is widely known as one of the most picturesque cricket stadiums in the world. Behold the stunning view of the mighty Dhauladhar mountain peaks in the backdrop, as you watch a wonderful cricket match.



The Kangra Art Museum

The Museum is a fascinating museum displaying artifacts from Tibetan and Buddhist cultures. Inaugurated in 1990, the museum has preserved a treasure trove from Kangra valley's cultural past, crafts, arts and other ancient artifacts including miniature paintings, temple carvings, fabrics and embroidery, weapons, and palanquins belonging to local royalty.

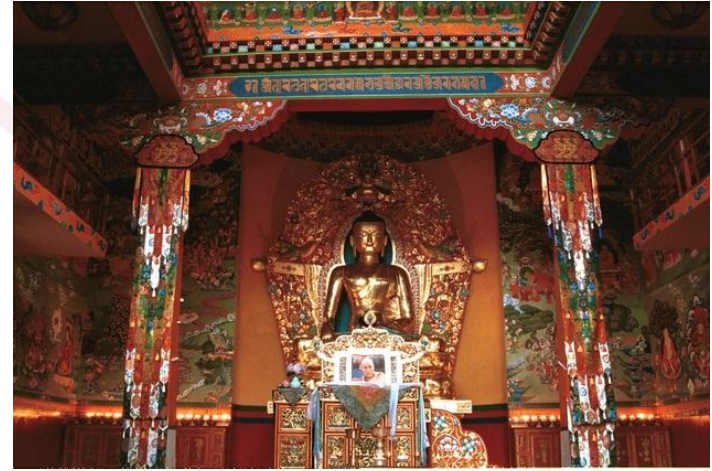


Namgyal Monastery

Monastery is also the home of the Tibetan spiritual leader the Dalai lama and the largest tibetan temple outside Tibet. This beautiful monastery was founded in the 16th century by the second Dalai lama and it was established so that Namgyal monks could assist the Dalai lama in public religious affairs

Norbulingka Institute

- Norbulingka institute was founded near Dharamshala in 1988 for preserving Tibetan culture, literature and art. The institute is named after Norbulingka, the summer residence of the Dalai lamas in Lhasa, Tibet.
- The institute primarily works towards carrying on Tibetan traditions and heritage by providing training, education and employment to Tibetans in the region.
- Norbulingka produces high quality art objects, clothing and home furnishings.
- You can watch the artists bringing life to the canvas upon which they seem to create magic with the use of vibrant colors, tailoring, weaving, etc.



Suggested Itinerary

Day 1: Arrivals

- Arrival at the Chandigarh Airport (Distance from Chandigarh Airport to Dharamshala is 258kms – 6 hrs)
- Proceed for Dharamshala; packed lunch boxes to be given on the way.
- Reach Dharamshala by evening & Check-in at the hotel
- Dinner at the hotel
- Overnight stay at the hotel



Day 2: Sightseeing in Dharamshala

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Proceed for sightseeing in Dharamshala:
 - Namgyal Monastery
 - Khangra Museum
 - Dal Lake
- For lunch proceed to Norbulingka Institute (Humming Bird Café)
- Rest of the day sightseeing at Norbulingka Institute
- Later on the way back, shopping drop in McLeod Ganj
- Return back to the hotel
- Gala Dinner at the hotel
- Overnight stay at the hotel

- Transfer back from Dharamshala to Chandigarh Airport.
