

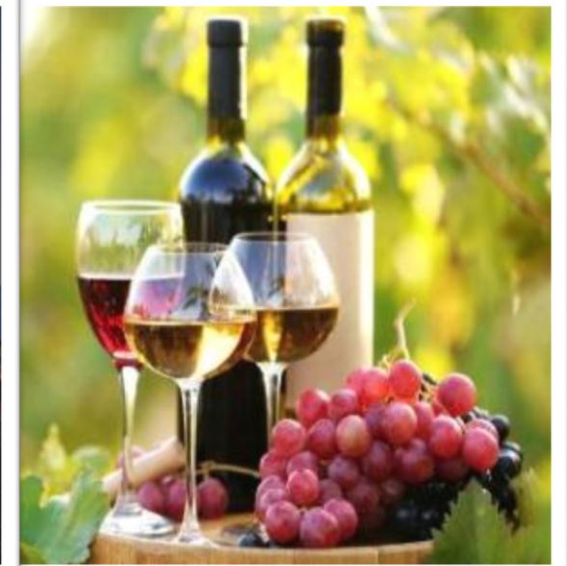
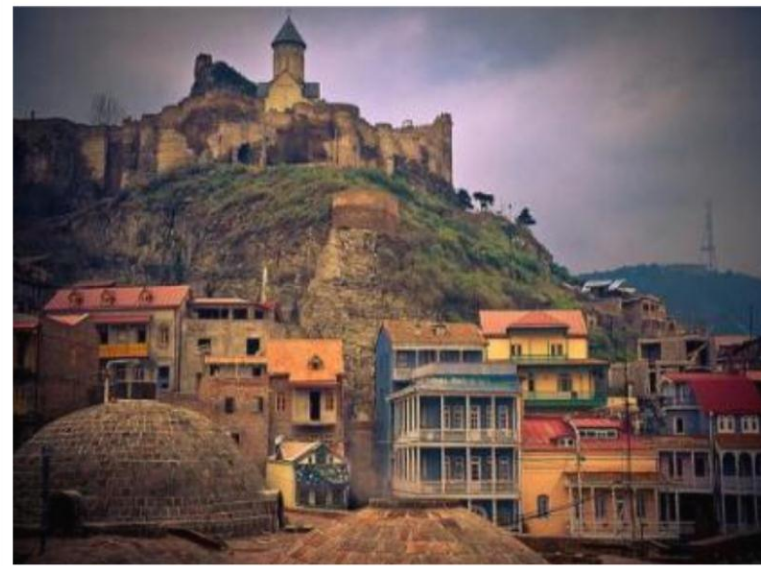

# Georgia - the cradle of wine

- Bordered by the Black Sea in the west, by Turkey and Armenia in the south, by Azerbaijan in the east, and Russia in the north. Georgia became a kingdom about 4 B.C. and Christianity was introduced in A.D. 337. During the reign of Queen Tamara (1184–1213), its territory included the whole of Transcaucasia.
- Georgia is a limited size of its territory, Georgia is rich in natural diversity that matches every requirement of travelers looking for specific type of museum for its archeological sites; the skulls of first European human beings were found on the territory of Georgia. Despite leisure and entertainment.
- Georgia and its wonderful people meet their guests with one of the most delicious cuisines of the world. They will be offered a chance to taste several hundred types of wine and witness the oldest ethnographic traditions of Georgia.
- Georgia is a wonderful tourist destination which can be visited any time in a year. The coldest months are December, January and February, while July and August are warm. In Tbilisi, average maximum temperature for January is 6° C, and for July-August, nearly 31° C. Night temperatures may dip below 0 degrees C in December, January and February. May, June, July and September are months of heavy rainfall.

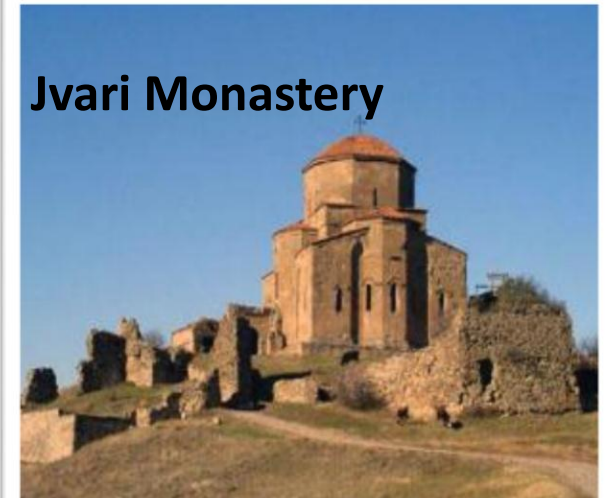

# Day 1-Arrival in Tbilisi (1500Hrs)

- Arrival at Tbilisi International Airport. Our local guide would meet you. Transfer to the hotel and check-in (1700 Hrs). Hi tea will be served.
- **Tbilisi Night City Tour: (1800hrs – 2000hrs)**
  - Visit Metekhi Church of blessed Virgin Mary (XIIIAC).
  - Walk through Park of Rike, where we can see the Peace Bridge (modern glass bridge)
  - Glance through the historic Anchiskhati church (IV century) and Sioni church ( XII)
  - Walk to Abanotubani (district of sulfur baths) – baths, built on natural hot sulfur springs in XVII-XIX, then Tbilisi Mosque and Synagogue.
  - Explore Narikhala fortress by Cable car - the old citadel. Head towards Rustaveli Avenue, which is the main street of the city.
  - Drive to visit Mtatsminda Park - family amusement facility. It offers carrousel, water slides, a roller-coaster, and a big Ferris Wheel at the edge of the mountain, offering a splendid view over the city. (All Inclusive)
  - Dinner at restaurant (Maharaja). Overnight in Tbilisi.

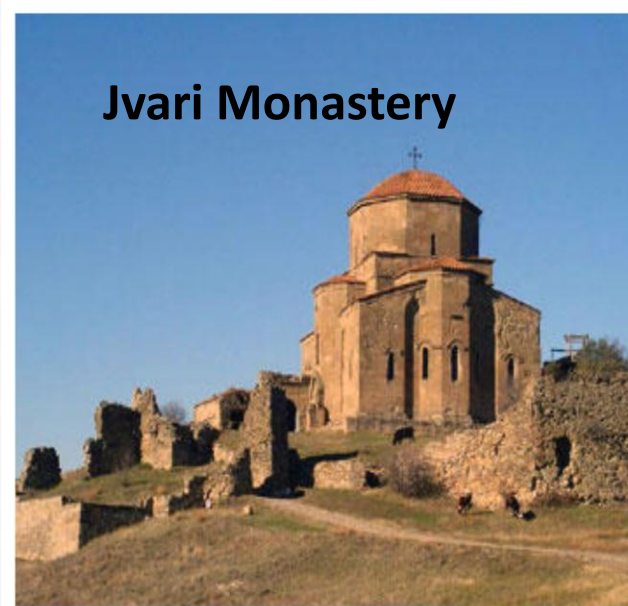

# DAY 2: Mtskheta - Borjomi Resort - Tbilisi Boat Tour tripnavigator.in

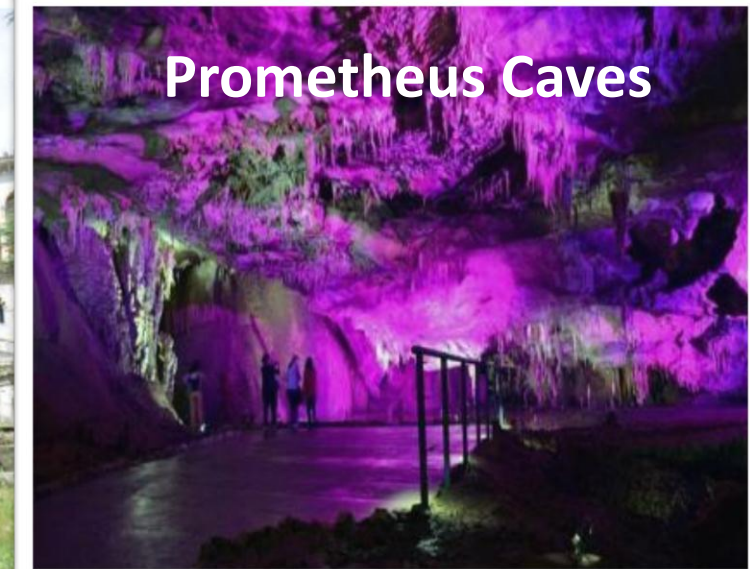
- Breakfast at the hotel and leave for Mtskheta at 09.30Hrs. Mtskheta, the ancient capital of Georgia which also marks the confluence of River Kura and Aragvi. Visit Jvari Monastery, erected on the top of the cliff.
- Proceed to Borjomi the resort town in the southwest of Georgia. The city is well-known for the mineral Borjomi water taking the first position on export in Georgia. Borjomi treats group of low-mountain resorts and is surrounded with a massif cover of coniferous and broad-leaved forests.
- Relish on local lunch at Borjomi.
- Return back to Tbilisi and refresh.
- Head for a Boat Tour by Night in Tbilisi (Mtkvari River), which takes around 1 hour incl. separate guide and music (Multiple Boats).
- Dinner at Maharaja Restaurant. Overnight in Tbilisi





# Day 3: Tbilisi - Kutaisi - Prometheus Cave - Batumi (8Hrs)

- (0930 hrs) Enjoy your breakfast and drive to Kutaisi. Here we will visit Gora Park, which is located on the hill above the city. The park can be reached by car or Cable car. Be stunned by mesmerizing views of the city.
- Lunch at Kutaisi.
- Afterwards drive to Tskaltubo to visit Prometheus Caves - one of Georgia's natural wonders providing visitors with breath-taking examples of stalactites, stalagmites, curtains, petrified waterfalls, cave pearls, underground rivers, and lakes.
- Drive to Batumi. Dinner at restaurant. Overnight in Batumi.





# Day 4: Batumi city Tour & Adjarian Wine House

- After Breakfast we will have walking tour through the magnificent seaside town, which is adorned with a memorable square "Piazza", a unique statue of Ali and Nino, a seaside Amusement Park, musical fountains, and other cultural sightseeing.
- Ride by cable car for amazing views over the city.
- Have lunch and proceed to Adjarian Wine House. We will drive to Winery "Adjarian wine house", where we will have a short excursion in the winery, wine testing.
- Return to Batumi for Yacht tour in Black Sea, which takes an hour.
- Dolphin's Show at 17:00hrs. Post this explore the beautiful city of Batumi on foot as it would be your last evening here.
- Overnight in Batumi

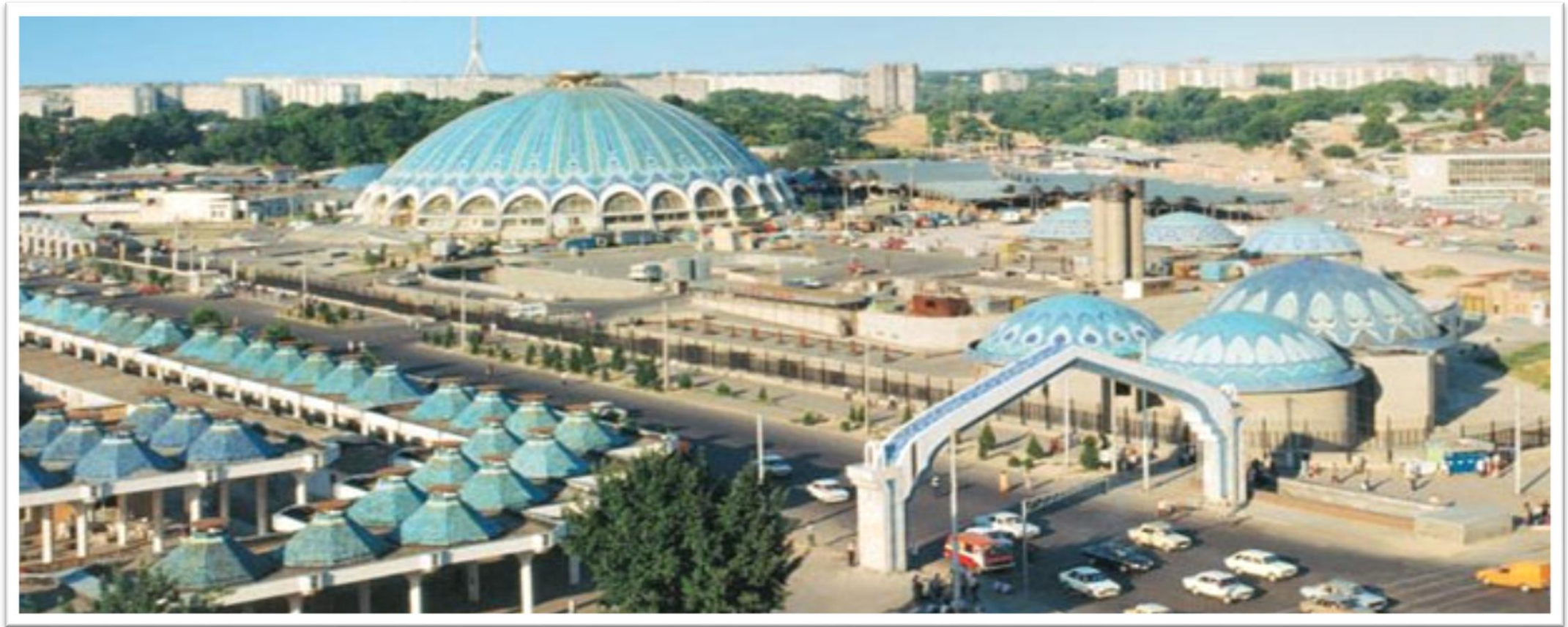
