# Overview

- Hyderabad is the capital of Indian state of Telangana.
- It is also known as 'City of Nizams' and 'City of pearls' as it has a glorious history.
- Hyderabad is also one of the most developed cities in the country with an established Information Technology (IT) hub and an emerging Bio-Technology hub. Hence, it is also a MICE Centric destination.
- Best time to visit is October to February when the climate is quite pleasant. The winter season in Hyderabad begins from the month of November and continues till February.



# How to reach Hyderabad

- **BY AIR** - Hyderabad has an international as well as domestic airport. The Rajiv Gandhi International terminal is well-connected with major cities across the globe. The airport's domestic terminal is called NT Rama Rao which is connected to most of the Indian cities. Approximately 20 kilometres away from the city, the airport is situated in the Begumpet area. Almost all airlines fly daily from and to Hyderabad.
- **BY RAIL** - There are three major railheads in the city, namely, Hyderabad Railway Station, Secunderabad Railway Station and Kachiguda Railway Station. The rail routes connect the city extensively to all over India. The railway stations are located close to the city.
- **BY ROAD** - Hyderabad enjoys regular services of state roadways and privately owned buses from the bus stand of the city. Roads are well linked with important cities and states.

# Attractions

## Charminar

- The structure was built in 1591 AD. It is based on Indo-Islamic architecture with Persian influence.
- It is the most famous building of Hyderabad and also one of the most famous buildings in India.
- It was built by Muhammad Quli Qutb Shahi to celebrate the end of a deadly plague as a vow was taken for the eradication of the plague.
- The Charminar lies near the bank of the river Musi.



## Sangareddy Jail

- The fact that it was built in 1796 during the Nizam era and has a proper heritage museum that one can explore makes it really awesome.
- You don't have to commit petty crime to spend a night in a prison.
- It has an interesting experience 'Feel The Jail' where any of us can spend a night inside a cell for just Rs.500 per pax.
- Distance from airport- 60km




# Chowmahalla Palace

- Chowmahalla Palace is a palace of the Nizams of Hyderabad state. It was the official residence of the Nizams of Hyderabad while they ruled their state.
- The palace was built by Nizam Salabat Jung. The palace remains the property of the Nizams. Other members of the Hyderabadi Nizam family have also wed here.

## Golconda Fort

- Golconda, also known as Golconda, Golkonda, or Gollakonda, is a fort in Southern India and was the capital of the medieval sultanate of the Qutb Shahi dynasty, which is situated 11 km west of Hyderabad.
- Famous diamonds like Koh-I-Noor and Dariya-noor were excavated from the mines of Golconda and were also stored in a vault inside the fort.



## Hussain Sagar Lake

- Hussain Sagar is a heart shaped lake in Hyderabad built by Nizam of Hyderabad
- It's chief engineer was Nawab Khan Bahadur Mirza Akbar Baig.
- It is spread across an area of 5.7 square kilometres and is fed by River Musi.
- It separates the twin sisters i.e. the city of Hyderabad and Secunderabad.



# Lumbini Park

- Situated quite close to the famous standing statue of Lord Buddha and Hussain Sagar Lake, the largest artificial lake of Asia.
- The Lumbini Park is a place worth visiting. An apt place for relaxation, this park is visited by many.
- The Musical fountain and water cascades attract everyone. The sight of water shooting up to the sky, making a screen where the history of Hyderabad is being shown is something not many of us have seen before.
- The best part of **laser show** is that you will see a city created in 3D right at a park.




# Salar Jung Museum

# Mecca Mosque

# Meena Bazaar & Laad Bazaar

- Adjacent to the monument, the Bazaar is stretched on four roads starting from Charminar and is spread across an area of one kilometre.
- The Bazaar still presents a glimpse of the bygone eras. It is said that the market has been there since the Qutub Shahis and the Nizams era and thus presents a living heritage of the city.
- The market, not just offers wide range of colour bangles to customers but also zari and embroidery works, sarees to other traditional clothing stuff along semi-precious stones. Laad bazaar pearls are equally famous too.



## Kesar & Chandan Sharbat

- Chandan Ka Sharbat is a refreshing drink made with an extra-ordinary fragrance of saffron & sandalwood and its essence.
- The name of the drink is quite strange, but it is one of the most famous and special Indian drink and highly served specially during festivals.



## Hyderabadi Biryani

- Hyderabadi biryani is generally believed to have originated in the kitchens of the Nizam of Hyderabad of the historic Hyderabad State, as a blend of Mughlai and Iranian cuisine.
- It is prepared from rice using the dum method of cooking.


