## Culture of Tashkent


- The culture of Uzbekistan is vibrant and unique.

### **Kukeldash Madrasah**

- It is a medieval madrasa in Tashkent.
- Its located close to Chorsu Bazaar and Chorsu Metro station.
- It was built around 1570 by the Shaybanid Dynasty of rulers.
- The madrasah is built of yellow brick, and has a traditional square shape with a big portal and an inner yard.
- Entrance fee: INR 100

### **Chorsu Bazar**

- Chorsu Bazaar is the traditional bazaar located in the center of the old town of Tashkent, the capital city of Uzbekistan.
- Under its blue-coloured domed building and the adjacent areas, all daily necessities are sold.







### **Amir Timur Square**

- The history of the square in the center of Tashkent named after Amir Timur, the commander and founder of a huge medieval empire, began as early as in the 19<sup>th</sup> century, when Tashkent was the center of the Turkestan Military Command, composing the Russian Empire.
- It was established by order of general M. Chernyaev in 1882.
- The square represented a small park in the center of the city, surrounded by buildings of women and men's gymnasium, normal school and state bank.
- Right in the center of the square, there is a monument to the outstanding commander and statesman of the 15<sup>th</sup> century Amir Timur, who managed to found a centralized united state composing of 27 countries in the vast territory from the Mediterranean Sea to India.
- The monument is represented as a bronze figure of Amir Timur with imperial regalia on a reared horse.
- The monument plinth is engraved with an Amir Timur's famous motto in four languages "Power is in Justice".









#### Lal Bahadur Shashtri

- For most of the residents of Tashkent, Shastri is a city landmark.
- Shastri is a great figure belonging to the same level of political figures as Mahatma Gandhi and Jawaharlal Nehru.
- Today there is a monument in the central part of the city on the crossroad dedicated to the person who had greatly contributed to the development of India and who had left a track in the history of not only India, but also Tashkent.



### Lake Charvak

- Lake Charvak is the uppermost of the several reservoirs made on the Chirchiq River.
- Downstream, there are Khodzhikent Reservoir and Gazalkent Reservoir, which have a much smaller area.
- Lake Charvak is a popular resort in Tashkent region.






#### **Tashkent TV Tower**

- The **Tashkent Television Tower** (Uzbek: Toshkent Teleminorasi) is a 375-metre-high (1,230 ft.) tower, located in Tashkent, Uzbekistan.
- Its the 11th tallest tower in the world.
- It was the 4<sup>th</sup> tallest tower in the world from 1985 to 1991.
- The tower has an observation deck located 97 metres (318 ft) above the ground.
- It is second tallest structure in Central Asia after Ekibastuz GRES-2 Power Station in Ekibastuz, Kazakhstan.
- It also belongs to the World Federation of Great Towers.
- Entrance Fee: INR 1000. You need your passport to buy a ticket.
- Opening hours: 10 20 Tue-Sun.







### **Chimgan Mountain:**

- Chimgan Is the most popular Ski resort In Uzbekistan.
- **Greater Chimgan** (3,309 m) of the Chatkal Mountain range (the Western Tian Shan) is located in the territory of the Ugam-Chatkal National Park, and it is in the Bostanlyk administrative district.
- Greater Chimgan is the main peak of the valley and stands out above the entire valley.
- Chimgan is popularly known as Uzbek Switzerland for its simply beauty.








# Day Trip to Samarkand



- Color Photo Specification 50 mm X 50 mm, 65% to 70% face cover with both the ears visible, no border, taken within 06 months, white background, only Studio photos accepted, scanned photos not acceptable.
- Hotel Confirmation Voucher
- Confirm the Airline ticket
