## Places to Visit



## **Golden Temple**

- Tangibly the most spiritual place in India, Golden Temple, also known as Sri Harmindar Sahib.
- It is a place that can only be experienced and not described.
- The Gurudwara teaches the lesson of egalitarianism and humility.
- The four entrances of this holy shrine from all four directions, signify that people belonging to every walk of life are equally welcome.



## Jallianwala Bagh

- Located near the famous Golden Temple of Amritsar, the Jallianwala Bagh is a public garden which houses a memorial to commemorate the massacre of peaceful celebrators by the British forces.
- The place has been turned into a beautiful park and is managed by the Jallianwala Bagh National memorial trust.
- A light and sound show is hosted here every evening.





#### Maharaja Ranjit Singh Museum

Summer palace turned into museum, Maharaja Ranjit Singh Museum is a lovely building which archives the Royal Heritage of Maharaja Ranjit Singh such as arms and armour, outstanding paintings and century old coins and manuscripts.



## Khair-ud-Din Masjid

Famous for its architecture, Khair-ud-Din Masjid was established by Mohd. Khair-ud-din. It was the place from where the great call for waging war against the looting British was announced by Tootie-e-Hind, Shah Attaullah Bukhari.



## **Bibeksar Sahib**

Bibeksar Sahib lying on the banks of Bibeksar Sarovar was constructed by Maharaja Ranjit Singh. The place is famous as the congregation site of followers of 6th Sikh Guru, Hargobind Singh ji.



## Wagah Border

The Wagah border, often called the "Berlin wall of Asia", is a ceremonial border on the India–Pakistan Border where each evening there is a retreat ceremony called 'lowering of the flags', which has been held since 1959.

At that time there is an energetic parade by the Border Security Force (B.S.F) of India and the Pakistan Rangers soldiers.

## Unique Experiences Harike Wetland & Wildlife Sanctuary







- **Harike Wetland** also known as "Hari-ke-Pattan is the largest wetland in northern India in Punjab.
- Covers an area of 4100 ha.
- Rich biodiversity of the wetland, with several species of birds, turtles, snakes and taxa of amphibians, fishes and invertebrates is some unique and registered to be endangered.
- 200 species of birds visit the wetland during winter season of which some of the well known species on the verge of extinction.
- 26 species of fish are recorded which include Endangered Testudines Turtle and Smooth Indian Otter or Smooth-coated Otter Redlist of Threatened Animals, are found in the wetland.
- The wetland's rich floating vegetation houses some exquisite scenes during season.

- The Langar at Golden Temple serves 50,000 people everyday and on holidays/religious occasions the counts goes to 1,00,000 people.
  - Serving these many people day after day is no easy task, but the clockwork efficiency of the sewadars (workers) makes the task simple.

- From chopping vegetables to making rotis and from serving people to washing the dishes, they can choose any task.






