# Overview

- The Philippines is a tropical country in Pacific Ocean, blessed with beautiful natural landscapes - and active volcanoes and extreme weather patterns.
- The Philippines, consisting of some 7,107 islands, is located in the western Pacific Ocean. Taiwan lies to its north, and Vietnam to the west.
- Of the top 10 largest shopping malls in the world, three are found in the Philippines: SM Megamall, SM North EDSA, and SM Mall of Asia.
- The Philippines is the world's largest exporter of coconuts and tropical fruits, such as papaya and mangosteen.
- The Philippines are most popular during the dry season, between November and April. At this time the country is fully accessible, including its many beautiful islands and more remote areas. Temperatures are high during March and April, so it's best to travel during the cooler months of December to February.

# HOTEL JEN MANILA (4 STAR)

- Rebranded by Shangri-La Hotels and Resorts in late 2014, Hotel Jen Manila (formerly Traders Hotel Manila) on Roxas Boulevard is just 400 metres from Manila's conference and exhibition centres.
- Hotel Jen Manila (formerly Traders Hotel Manila) is just 20-minutes' drive from Ninoy Aquino International Airport.
- Consist of 312 rooms



# MANILA HOTEL (5 STAR)

# VISA PROCEDURE:

- Application for a temporary visitor's visa must be made in person. In the case of a minor under eighteen (18) years of age, the application may be made for him by a person who, in the opinion of the consular officer, is responsible for his/her welfare. The minor, not an infant in arms, shall be required to appear at the Consulate for interview, together with the person making the application for him/her.
- Applicants for temporary visitor's visa should normally apply at the Philippine Embassy or Consulate that has jurisdiction over their place of residence. While some visa applicants may apply at any Philippine Embassy or Consulate abroad, others are only allowed to apply his/her visa at the Philippine Embassy or Consulate in his country of origin or legal residence.

The following are the minimum requirements for applying a temporary visitor's visa:

1. Passport/Travel Document Valid for at least six (6) months beyond the intended period of stay in the Philippines;
2. Duly Accomplished Visa application forms;
3. Passport Photos (2 pieces);
4. Proof of bona fide status as tourist or businessman;
5. Confirmed tickets for return or onward journey to the next port of destination; and
6. Payment of Visa Fees



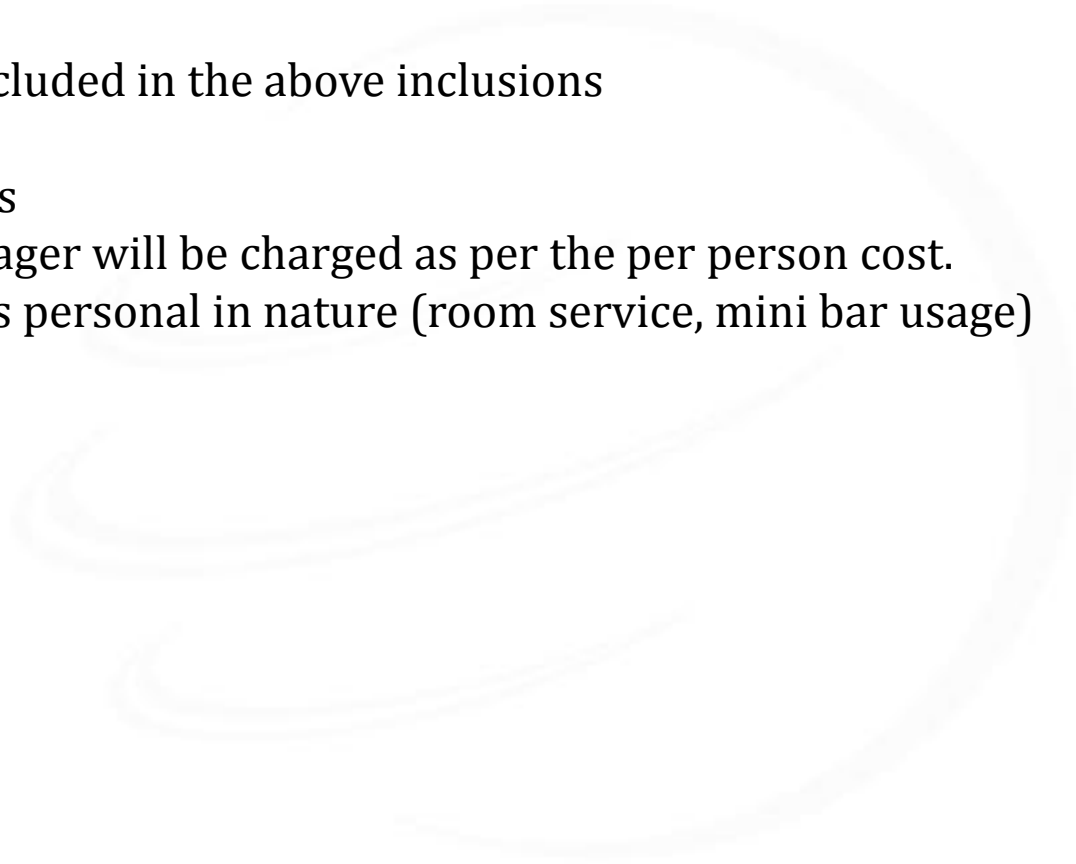
