Overview of Spain

- Spain, a country on Europe's Iberian Peninsula, includes 17 autonomous regions with diverse geography and cultures. Capital city Madrid is home to the Royal Palace and Prado museum, housing works by European masters. Segovia has a medieval castle (the Alcaraz) and an intact Roman aqueduct. Catalonia's capital, Barcelona, is defined by Antoni Gaudi's whimsical modernist landmarks.
- The best time to visit the Barcelona and Madrid is from May to June when balmy temperatures in the low to mid-70s mesh with a flurry of festivals that trumpet the advent of summer. Both the cities are an integral part of the Spanish culture. The country also is home to La Liga football league and is home to two biggest football clubs in the world.
- Barcelona is also home to one of the best nightlife in the world with few of the best nightclubs located within the city.

in Barcelona

La Sagrada Familia

- The Basilica de la Sagrada Familia, also known as the Sagrada Familia, is a large unfinished Roman Catholic minor basilica in Barcelona, Catalonia. Designed by Catalan architect Antoni Gaudi, his work on the building is part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- It's best to visit in the early morning or late evening as the sun shines through the stained glass windows on the walls filling the church with an abundance of colour. You're also likely to have less of a wait and crowd to navigate through around these times.



Park Güell

- The Park Güell is a public park system composed of gardens and architectonic elements located on Carmel Hill, in Barcelona, Catalonia, Spain. Carmel Hill belongs to the mountain range of Collserola – the Parc del Carmel is located on the northern face.



Font Magica

- The Montjuïc Magic Fountain has become one of Barcelona's most popular attractions and is where the "Piromusical" is held, a true balletic spectacle of water and light.
- Barcelona's biggest ornamental fountain, which was built in 1929 for the International Exhibition, offers a spectacular display of music, water acrobatics and lights which generate over 50 kinds of shades and hues.



La Rambla

- Las Ramblas is often the first landmark that most tourists identify with the city. It is a large boulevard which runs through the heart of the city centre. It is filled with Barcelona action at its best
- Attractions along the Ramblas including live performances, human statue art, artists that will draw your portrait or caricature.
- La Ramblas presents the best night life Barcelona has to offer



Montserrat

- Montserrat is a spectacularly beautiful Benedictine monk mountain retreat about one hour North West from Barcelona by train.
- Not only is Montserrat Monastery of significant religious importance but the natural beauty surrounding the monastery is simply breathtaking.

Watch a match at Camp Nou

- Camp Nou is the home stadium of FC Barcelona since its completion in 1957. With a seating capacity of 99,354, it is the largest stadium in Spain and Europe, and the third largest football stadium in the world in capacity.
- Visit the home ground of FC Barcelona for a tour of the famous stadium or choose to watch a match along with electrifying fans from across the world.



Visit the Gothic Quarters

- The charming Gothic Quarter, or Barri Gòtic, has narrow medieval streets filled with trendy bars, clubs and Catalan restaurants. The Museum d'Història de Barcelona shows remains of the Roman city. Artisans sell leather and jewellery near the Cathedral of Barcelona, while flower stalls and street-food vendors line busy avenue La Rambla. The Plaça del Pi, named after the adjacent Gothic church, hosts a weekend art market.



Visit the Barceloneta Beach

- The beach is inextricably linked to the fishing quarter of the same name, Barceloneta, Barcelona's classic neighbourhood by the sea, where the people of Barcelona love to come and eat fish and seafood dishes and "tapas".
- Located in the traditional fishing district, this is one of Barcelona's oldest and best-loved beaches. It is thought to have inspired Miguel de Cervantes as the setting for the fight between Don Quixote and the Knight of the White Moon. It was here that the knight errant was finally defeated and abandoned his quest.



Things to do at Madrid

Visit the Temple of Debod

- The Temple of Debod is an ancient Egyptian temple that was dismantled and rebuilt in Madrid, Spain. The shrine was originally erected 15 kilometres south of Aswan in Upper Egypt, very close to the first cataract of the Nile and to the great religious centre in Philae dedicated to the goddess Isis.



Visit the Royal Palace of Madrid

- The Royal Palace of Madrid is the official residence of the Spanish royal family at the city of Madrid, although now only used for state ceremonies. The palace has 135,000 square metres of floor space and contains 3,418 rooms. It is the largest functioning royal palace and the largest by floor area in Europe.



Visit to Palacio de Cristal del Retiro

- The Palacio de Cristal is a conservatory located in Madrid's Buen Retiro Park. It was built in 1887 on the occasion of the Exposition of the Philippines, held in the same year, then a Spanish colonial possession. The architect was Ricardo Velázquez Bosco.



Tour of Santiago Bernabeu Stadium

- The Santiago Bernabéu Stadium is a football stadium in Madrid, Spain. With a current seating capacity of 81,044, it has been the home stadium of Real Madrid since its completion in 1947. The Santiago Bernabéu is one of the world's most famous football venues.
- Visit the home ground of Real Madrid for a tour of the famous stadium or choose to watch a match along with electrifying fans from across the world.



Experience a Bullfight

- Madrid and Andalusia are the dual epicentres of bullfighting in Spain. Despite most people's impression of bullfighting as being unique to the whitewashed villages of Andalusia and Costa Blanca, Madrid is a great place to see a bullfight in Spain. The city attracts fewer tourists and more real aficionados than some of the bullfights in Andalusia.
- Bullfights are scheduled every Sunday (during the season) at 7 p.m. from mid-May (during the San Isidro festival) until October. There is no bullfighting in Madrid outside the season.



Visa Requirements

- Passport: Original Passport with validity of minimum three months and two blank pages for visa stamp.
 - a) Required photocopies of all the pages of the current and previous passport (if any).(even the blank pages)
Please note
 - a) Passports issued beyond 10 years will not be accepted by the Embassy
 - b) Attach all your old passports (if any)
- [Schengen Visa Application Form](#) : One visa application form with two copies duly typed and signed on column 37 and 38 in Blue ink only.
The following form also need to be duly filled, signed and submitted along with the application
 - a) [Spain Authorisation Form](#)
 - b) [Spain Supplementary Form](#)
 Please note : Applicant mobile number should be mentioned in visa form as Embassy / Consulate can contact the applicant at any point of time during visa processing
- Photo Specification: Two recent passport size photographs with matt or semi matt finish, 60%-80% face coverage, white background and without border (Size: 35mm x 45mm)
For Chennai: Two recent passport size photographs with glossy finish, 60%-80% face coverage, white background and without border (Size: 35mm x 45mm)
Please note: Photograph should not be more than 3 months old, scanned/stapled and should not be used in any of the previous visas.
- [Covering Letter](#) : Covering-Letter from applicant on business letter head mentioning name, designation passport number, purpose and duration of visit in brief. The letter should be duly signed by authorized signatory with company stamp and addressed to – The Consulate General of Spain, Mumbai
Please Note:
 - a) Covering-Letter on Letterhead if applicant is Self Employed or on plain paper if Employed.
 - b) Please Note: Post visa processing, BLS will courier the passport directly to the applicant at an additional cost of Rs 300. Therefore, it is mandate to mention the complete dispatch address on the covering-letter.

 - d) Copy of Pan Card
 - If Self Employed
 - a) Personal Income tax returns (ITR V) for the last three years. In case, the returns have not been filed, submit a letter of explanation.
 - b) An Original personal bank statement of past 1 year ,with the original stamp and signature of authorized signatory of the bank (Online Bank statements are not acceptable).
 - c) Copy of Pan Card
 - Proof of Occupation:
 - Self Employed
 - a) Company Registration Certificate / Certificate of Incorporation / Proof of Proprietorship / Partnership Deed
 - b) Brief Company Profile
 - c) Articles of Memorandum (Incase the applicant is MD/Director)
 - Employed
 - a) Proof of employment like Appointment Letter / NOC from Employer

- [Spain Authority Letter Mumbai](#) to be filled by the applicant if he/she has undergone biometrics and authorize an agent to submit the documents on his / her behalf. The authority letter must be notarized.
- Please Note:
a) Visa application has to be submitted 10 working days prior to the travel.
b) Applicants who are applying applications with their families have to submit the proof of family relation. If husband & wife are applying together, applicants have to show Original Marriage Certificate & in case of Child, Birth Certificate is required at the time of submission or in case of photocopy, then the same has to be Notarized.
- New Procedure for Schengen Visa Applications: With immediate effect, Indian citizens travelling to Schengen countries for short-term (max 90 days in 180 days) will have to visit BLS visa application centre personally to provide biometric data (fingerprints and digital photograph). For subsequent applications within next 5 years the biometric data will be copied from the previous visa application included in the VIS.
