


Introduction -

- Its heart is the Bund, a famed waterfront promenade lined with colonial-era buildings.
- Across the Huangpu River rises the Pudong district's futuristic skyline

Overview

Shanghai is unique in its cultural division between Pudong and Puxi, the city's two main neighbourhoods. These opposing parts of town—named after their location in relation to the Huangpu River, with "dong" meaning east and "xi" meaning west—are completely different culturally as well as geographically.

PUXI-

- Pronounced "poo shee," Puxi is the historical heart of the city.
- It is in this area that the historical houses and buildings (or what's left of them), the Bund, and the famous Art Deco heritage architecture are found.

PUDONG-

- Just a few decades ago, Pudong was home to a slew of warehouses as well as farming and fishing communities, Now, it is home to some of the tallest buildings in China, such as the Shanghai Tower and the Shanghai World Financial Center.
- Whereas Puxi is somewhat of a blast of Shanghai's past, Pudong is a glimpse into its future. The distinction between the two cities is almost alarming as you look out across the Huangpu River at the opposing skyline.



Yu Garden-

- Yu Garden, aka Yuyuan Garden, Yu Yuan in Chinese, is a classical garden ranking among the must-see attractions in Huangpu District, Shanghai.
- It dates back to the Ming Dynasty (1368-1644) and was owned by a government officer named Pan Yunduan.
- Yu in Chinese means pleasing and satisfying, and this garden was specially built for Pan's parents as a place for them to enjoy a tranquil and happy time in their old age.
- The Garden is around 400 years old and 20,000 square meters (five acres)
- Entry fees -Apr. Jun. & Sep. Nov.: CNY 40 Jul. & Aug. & Dec. Mar.: CNY 30
- Opening hours 8:45 to 16:45 (closed on Monday & national holidays)








Shanghai Finance Centre

- Standing in the center of Lujiazui in Pudong area_and neighbouring Shanghai Tower and Jin Mao Tower, Shanghai World Financial Center (SWFC) is the second tallest skyscraper in the city up to now. From the exterior, the structure looks like a bottle opener and that's exactly its nickname.
- Aiming to be a magnet of the world's finance, Shanghai WFC boasts functions of first class financial centres, able to showcase monetary talents, cultural and art exhibitions and information from all over the world. For tourists, it's more of a hot attraction featuring the sightseeing observatories and the Park Hyatt Hotel.







Sightseeing Arena on 94F (423 meters / 1,388 feet) & Sightseeing Observatory on 97F (439 meters / 1,440 feet)

- It provides a perfect and extensive view of Shanghai along the Huangpu river The 750-square-meter (about 897-square-yard) sightseeing hall is also suitable for exhibitions.
- A café bar and a souvenir store can be found there.
- The observatory is a 55-meter-long (60-yard-long) corridor. While wandering on the floor made of transparent glass

• The Shanghai Museum is a museum of ancient Chinese art, situated on the People's Square in the Huangpu District of Shanghai, China. Rebuilt at its current location in 1996, it is considered one of China's first world-class modern museums

- Shanghai Museum has five floors containing the best in ancient Chinese history: old coins, priceless paintings and ceramics, intricately carved traditional lacquer furniture, and ancient bronze and jade artefacts.
- The museum has more than 120,000 pieces divided among 11 galleries. Even the building itself is a work of art, with the round dome representing heaven and the square base, land. Best of all, the museum offers free admission to 8,000 people every day.
- Opening hours 9:00hrs to 17:00hrs

• The Jade Buddha Temple is a Buddhist temple in Shanghai. As with many modern Chinese Buddhist temples, the current temple draws from both the Pure Land and Chan traditions of Mahayana Buddhism.

- It was founded in 1882 with two jade Buddha statues imported to Shanghai from Myanmar by sea.
- It is famous for the two pieces of Jade Buddha one is the sitting Jade Buddha of 1.95 meters tall and the other is the smaller reclining Jade Buddha of 0.96 meters tall
- Opening hours 8:00 to 16:30 (Tuesday to Sunday)







Shanghai International circuit

- Shanghai International Circuit is located, Jiading District, 30 kilometers (18.6 miles) from the city center, 25 kilometers (15.5 miles) from Hongqiao Airport and 55 kilometers (34.2 miles) from Pudong Airport.
- It is where the Formula 1 Grand Prix in ed in the northeast of Anting TownChina is held. Covering an area of 5.3 square kilometer (1,310 acres), it comprises the circuit area itself, a business exhibition area with shopping mall and racing car exhibition hall, leisure zone including fitness facilities, cinema, pub, and hotel, and an area reserved for future development.
- The circuit is still open to the public on days without events, but visitors need to pay CNY 50 as the entrance fee.







People Square

- People's Square is a major transport hub that draws visitors to Nanjing West Road, a main shopping street with malls offering local fashion and electronics, and food stalls selling kebabs and scallion pancakes.
- The area is known for landmarks like the Shanghai Museum, with calligraphy scrolls and bronze vessels, and the Shanghai Grand Theatre. Calm, leafy People's Park is home to the Museum of Contemporary Art.







Qibao Ancient Town

- Located in the center of Minhang District of Shanghai, only 18 kilometers (11.18 miles) from the downtown area, Qibao Ancient Town can satisfy your curiosity about ancient water townships without the bother of either long distance or the rush of crowds.
- The town includes Qiboa ancient temple, Crickets fights, Shandow play, snacks corners etc
- Entrance fees Free entry to the town, need to pay for the attractions, CNT 5 to 10
- Opening hours All day long, attractions 9:00 to 18:00.







Oriental Pearl Tower-

- As one of the most substantial landmarks of the city, the Oriental Pearl Tower is a staple of the Lujiazui skyline the futuristic facade of Pudong. Confronting the Bund across the river Huangpu river, its 468-meter height and consists of 11 spheres of different sizes, inspired by the image of "pearls falling into a jade plate".
- From the three main platforms of the tower, during the day visitors and residents can appreciate the hallmark views of both riverbanks. When night falls, you can climb up to the sightseeing floor to look out over the sleepless city.



Chongming Island-

- Chongming, formerly known as Chungming, is an alluvial island at the mouth of the Yangtze River in eastern China covering 1,267 square kilometers as of 2010.
- Together with the islands Changxing and Hengsha, it forms Chongming County, the northernmost area of the provincial-level municipality of Shanghai.







Things to do at Chongming Island

Dongping National Forest

- Dongping National Forest Park is in the centre of Chongming Island, Shanghai.
- Covering an area of 1.4 square miles (3.55 square kilometres), it has the largest man-made forest in east China with a forest coverage rate of 90%.
- Besides the thick forest, dotted lakes, and elegant gardens, there are also many recreational activities, such as grass skiing, rock climbing, forest driving range, and forest sunbath.
- The barbeque and camping base offer much fun for families and outdoor vacationers, making the park a
 popular weekend destination
- Entry fees CNY 60 (Monday to Friday 8:30 to 16:00 & Weekends and holiday 8:30 to 17:00)







Swan Lake

There is a shooting range on the south bank, where you can play paintball with your friends. To the east is Baizhu Garden with more than ten species of bamboo, stretching along Yongcui Lake. The garden is divided into several flowerbeds. Bamboos there are all elaborately clipped into different styles, injecting vitality into the garden.

Dwan Redwood Lake

Dawn Redwood Lake area contains most of the recreational activities, such as arrow shooting, horseback-riding, kart, bumper car, racing car and grass skiing. In addition to the entertainment facilities, you can also wander in the nearby Maple Garden and Sakura Garden, breathing the sweet air and enjoying the delightful scenery of flamboyant maples and full-blown flowers.

Bird watching terrace

There are plenty of trees in Dongping National Forest Park. Numerous migratory birds come to the park to reproduce all year round except winter. The birds' migration is the most spectacular sight in the park. At the southwest corner of the park, a terrace, equipped with two high-power telescopes, was specially built for visitors on the north bank of Longce Lake to watch this scene.

Barbeque and camping base

You can have a picnic or camp out at the northwest corner of the park. There is a grill zone to the north of Luming Lake, providing visitors fresh ingredients. After eating and drinking, lying on the grass is a good choice to relax. You can spend the night in the camping area enjoying the bright moon and starry sky, if you like. With the chirping of insects around, you will feel truly relaxed. You don't have to bring all your own equipment. There are tents and sleeping bags for rent.


Novotel Atlantis Shanghai


