- Home to a few UNESCO World Heritage sites including Amer Fort and Jantar Mantar, Jaipur is home to many magnificent forts, palaces, temples and museums.
- One of the largest cities in India, Jaipur is also home to all the modern amenities with some of the most exotic hotels and resorts in the world.

Jaipur Connectivity

By Air

- Sanganer airport is the nearest airport to the city of Jaipur. It is located at a distance of 10 kilometres from the city centre. The airport has flight connectivity with major Indian cities like Mumbai and Delhi.

By Rail

 The railway junction at Jaipur connects it with various cities. For a royal experience one can take the Palace on Wheels. This train leaves from Delhi and connects various cities in Rajasthan.

 Jaipur has good network of roads connecting it with major Indian cities. NH 8, NH 11 and NH 12 are the main national highways connecting the city of Jaipur with other cities. National capital New Delhi is just 235 KM from this beautiful city while the city of the Taj Mahal, Agra, is only 220 KM from here.

- In the 16th century, a fort was build by a trusted general of Akbar, Maan Singh in Amer state.
- The fort now is known as Amer fort.
- Amer fort was built using red stones and white stones.
- The fort still portraits the ancient Indian Architecture.
- There are unique structures of gate in fort with great architecture.
- Amer fort is 11kms. from Jaipur city.



Jantar Mantar

- The Jantar Mantar monument in Jaipur which was built by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II.
- The astrological watch Jantar Mantar is a UNESCO world heritage site.
- It features the world's largest stone sundial.
- The instruments allow the observation of astronomical positions with the naked eye.
- Jantar Mantar is 6kms from Jaipur city.






Hawa Mahal

- Hawa Mahal or the 'Palace Of The Winds' is located in the heart of the beautiful Pink City of Jaipur in Rajasthan.
- This beautiful structure is predominantly a high screen wall made of pink and red sandstone that facilitated royal women to get an eyeful of the street festivals and busy city life while remaining out of the view of public.
- The mahal is of 5 storey with 953 windows.
- The Hawa mahal was built in 1799.
- Hawa mahal is 5.5kms from Jaipur city.

City Palace

- The magnificent City Palace in Jaipur is one of the most famous tourist attractions in the city.
- Built by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh during the years 1729 to 1732, the vast complex of the palace occupied one-seventh of the walled city.
- The museum showcases various unique handcrafted products and other things that belong to the royal heritage of the City Palace. The historical structure is located in the old part of Jaipur city and can be easily located and reached by any means of transport.





Jaigarh Fort

- Jaigarh Fort is situated on the promontory called the Cheel ka Teela (Hill of Eagles) of the Aravalli range; it overlooks the Amer Fort and the Maota Lake, near Amer in Jaipur, Rajasthan, India.
- The fort was built by Jai Singh II in 1726 to protect the Amer Fort and its palace complex and was named after him.
- Jaigarh Fort and Amber Fort are connected by subterranean passages and considered as one complex.
- Jaigarh fort is 16kms from the Jaipur city.



Nahargarh Fort

- Nahargarh Fort, along with other two forts viz., Amer Fort and Jaigarh Fort, once formed a strong defence for Jaipur city.
- Built by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II in 1734, this fort was originally named Sudarshangarh Fort.
- Later, it was given a new name, Nahargarh which means 'abode of tigers'.
- Located in oldest mountain ranges of the world, the Aravalli Hills, this fort gives you a breath-taking view of the scenic surroundings.





Albert Hall Museum

- Albert hall museum is mostly known as Government Central Museum.
- The marvellous construction was built in 19th century by Maharaja Sawai Ram
- Singh II when Prince of Whales was visiting India.
- The museum display thousands of historic item like, Apparels,
 Jewellery, weapons, artifacts and many more that belongs to Royal Rajasthan Family.
- The museum is 4kms from the Jaipur city.



Jaipur Zoo


- Jaipur Zoo was opened in 1877 near Albert hall museum.
- The zoo is divide into two parts for mammals and other for birds, reptiles.
- The wildlife zoo is spread in 35kms.
- The zoo is house for 550 animals approx. of 50 species.
- The zoo is around 04kms from the Jaipur city.



Hot Air Balloon Ride

- Lasting for approximately one hour, a hot air balloon ride is one of the most exciting activities to indulge in Jaipur.
- The hot air balloon activity is conducted from Amber Fort, Jal Mahal, Shiv Vilas and Delhi-Jaipur Road are some common locations. The site keeps on changing depending upon the direction of the wind. The take-off location is mainly decided by the pilot, considering the safety of passengers.
- The usual timings for the hot air balloon activity are 5:30 AM during April-June (no evening rides due to immense heat), 6:15 AM and 4:00 OM during September- November and 6:45 AM and 3:30 PM during December to March.
- On an average, the price for an adult is INR 7500 and INR 6000 for a child.
- The Balloon safari can take 10-12 people at once.







Ele Fantastic

- The elephants here are treated nicely, and it also boasts of its great hospitality, extreme geography, kaleidoscopic culture, deep-rooted spirituality, photogenic chaos and love for animals.
- Elefantastic provides a safe house for the elephants and also educates about daily life and the events of elephants.
- Activities at Elefantastic:
 - Watch the daily life of the elephants
 - Go for an elephant ride
 - > Interact with the mahouts
 - Get involved in Human-Elephant Interaction

Amer fort Elephant Ride

- One of the highlights of a visit to the stunning Amer Fort is the chance to ride an elephant up the hill to the main entrance.
- for the elephant to slowly trudge up the hillside to the main courtyard. The Jaipur government fixes these rates, so touts who try to sell more expensive pre-booked rides are simply conning visitors.
- There are approximately 80 elephants, which carry up 900 visitors per day.
- It is therefore recommended to visit the Amer Fort early in the day (before 9:00 am), to guarantee a ride and avoid the queues.
- The elephants are limited to five trips and carry only 2 passengers.

Elephant ride costs : Rs 1,000/- for two people

Duration Required: It takes approximately 20-30 minutes

(depending on elephant traffic!)







Chokhi Dhani

- Choki Dhani comprises of a series of rebuilt village huts with cow dung plasters and decorative wall art.
- Best time to visit: October to March
- Sightseeing inside Choki Dhani:
 - Relive the Haldighati Battle
 - Traditional folk dance performance
 - Puppet Show
 - Magic Show
 - Animal Rides
 - Chaupal (Chaupal literally means 'Hub' and is a traditional sit-down restaurant where you can enjoy a traditional Rajasthani meal)
 - National Museum at Choki Dhani

Entry fee: INR 700 per person for adults and INR 400 per child.

Timing: 5 PM to 11 PM.

- Moto sport park is the ideal venue for a magical and memorable evening.






Unique Dining Experiences



Cuisines of Jaipur



Dal Baati Churma

- The baatis are these round balls of dough that are stuffed and baked over charcoal fire, as a distant plump cousin of usual Indian rotis!
- Churma is the sweet accompaniment with the dish, made of jiggery or sugar and a hearty dose of ghee.
- Dal is lentil curry that adds the most flavour to the dish.



Laal Maas

- The hero of any Rajasthani meal is the crowd pleaser of centuries **Laal Maas**.
- The colour red (laal) comes from the hearty dose of red chillies added to the dish.
- This is a dish you must try with either bajra rotis or just plain rice and is a dish that never disappoints you.

Mawa Kachori

- Rajasthani Mawa Kachori is a wholly different story, because it is stuffed with sugary goodness, of mawa and is available in every local sweet shop,
- Try it with a hefty serving of sugar syrup and you'll be done for your afternoon slump!



Churma Ladoos

- A Rajasthani feast will only be complete after one samples these sugary pleasures of churma ladoos!
- They are rolled in desi ghee and usually served soft after dal baati churma. The <u>real taste of Rajasthan</u> lies in these laddoos.
